NEW BUSINESS

Community Survey Results for Support of Proposed Renovation Bond Dr. Timothy McLarney, of True North Research, presented results of the Community Phone Survey held in February 2015 and designed to evaluate the feasibility of a bond. Successful measure passage requires supporting votes from two-thirds (66%) of the Placentia voting community. As survey responses resulted in only a 58-62% positive support level. After presenting his findings, Dr. McLarney recommended that the Library Board of Trustees not move forward with a ballot measure for a Library Renovation Bond at this time. (Item 27)

Charles Heath, of TBWB Strategies, supported the survey findings and agreed that moving forward with a bond measure is not feasible at this time. After discussion of the survey results, the Board of Trustees voted to seek alternative options to finance renovation of the Placentia Library building. Trustee Minter expressed appreciation for Director Contreras' efforts.

Call for Nominations for CSDA Board of Directors

Library Director Contreras presented an opportunity for Trustees to be nominated for a seats on the 2015 CSDA Board of Directors, whose monthly meetings are held in Sacramento. No trustees were interested in participating at this time. (Item 28)

DISCUSSION

Library Director Contreras presented details of proposed budgets for fiscal years 2015 through 2017. The proposed 2015-2016 Library Budget is based on an expected 4% property tax income and includes a 10% budget allotment for books and library materials purchases, as well as salary for the re-instated Library Services Manager position. The 2015-2017 Library Budget is based on an expected property tax income of 4%, and includes an 11% budget allotment for books and materials purchases. Director Contreras also recommended no COLA salary increases for either fiscal year in order to achieve a balanced budget.

Library Director Contreras presented for Trustee approval a revised organizational chart and revised job descriptions for some library staff, to include changes in reporting hierarchy with the addition of a Library Services Manager. Librarian II positions are recommended to be re-titled as "Supervising Librarian" positions for Adult Services, Childrens Services and the Circulation/ Technology department.

Library Director Contreras presented revisions to Policy 6030-Circulation to reflect a more uniform, 2-week loan period for all library rental materials. Item loan limit is recommended as a total of 25 items (books, games, audio books, CDs, etc.) and 5 resources per patron. DVDs become 1-week rental items at no charge, with fines incurred if not returned within a week.

Library Director Contreras presented revisions to Policy 6035-Fines and Fees Schedule to accommodate process changes in the Circulation/Technology department. Fines will be charged per day, per item, with a maximum fine of \$20 per item. Reserved books will be complimentary and if not picked up within 3 days, a re-shelving fee will be charged to patron library cards.

Following the budget discussion, Trustees expressed their preference for annual COLA increases for staff, and requested that Director Contreras revise the budgets and expected property tax income, to include annual COLA increases if possible.

Based on Trustee direction and recommendations, Library Director Contreras will present revised budgets for 2015-16 and 2016-17, and a drawing of the planned One Service Desk, at a continued Budget Work Session on Tuesday, April 7, 2015 at 5:30pm. At that time, Trustees will also determine a date in April 2014 for the Public Meeting.

This was a continuation of discussions from the March 23rd Budget Work Session, where the Trustees requested budget revisions that would include an annual COLA for staff. To meet the Trustees' request, Director Contreras recommends outsourcing the Business Manager responsibilities and having a Support Services Manager for internal library operations, and a Public Services Manager to oversee both the Adult and Children's Services departments. Both positions

will be recruited from current library staff. Director Contreras recommends projecting the budget for Fiscal Year 2015-2017 based on a 4% property tax increase, which includes a 2.5% COLA per year for 2015-16 and 2016-17. (Item 5)

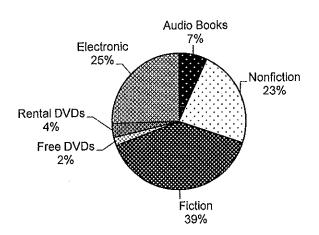
