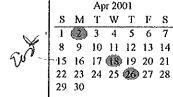
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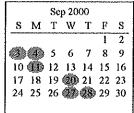

REPORT OF ACTIVITIES:

We have recently visited the Escondido Public Library History Room facility in connection with our search for a more userfriendly software system. We were more reinforced with our thinking rather than adding to our knowledge. An aspect which has this facility bogged down is the geneology materials which have come with the benefactor's funds. Materials of that sort have not been part of our mission; indeed a quantity of printed geneology text materials have been retrieved, at our request, by the donor, with the hope these materials can be located where they can be more fully utilized.

Regarding our software needs, we have concluded that a meeting with the Library's consultant would be helpful; at that time we could identify our classification system and Elizabeth could articulate the needs of the library to have inventory on the LAN. Since some of our materials are entered into the History Data Base, now in use, we would hope that this inventory could be downloaded into whatever new system works.

Our Building Bridges to Placentia History will meet next Tuesday. Our job will be to develop an Action Plan. We have reported back on the various ideas and now need to see where those ideas take us.

Planning for the city's 75th anniversary is the responsibility of the Cultural Arts Commission in partnership with the Heritage Days Committee and the Historical Committee. Ideas generated by the Building Bridges group will be passed on through the city's representative to this group. It appears that the Cult.Arts Commission will create a master calendar so that various groups within the city can generate their own celebration.

Five or six History's Mysteries for presentation on the Website have been provided to Jim. We continue to seek historical information from various groups in the city to be included.

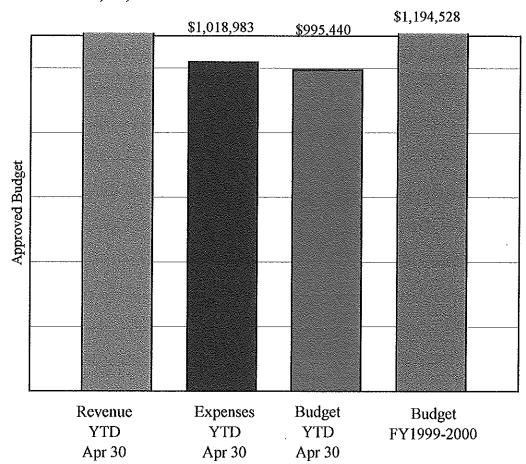
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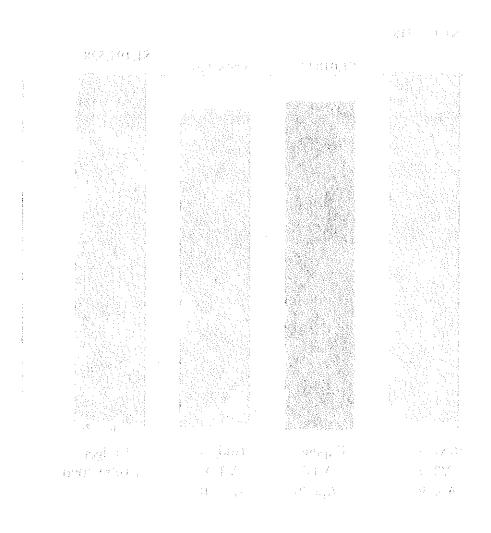

And for those who attended our meeting on Thursday, April 27, we experienced that it can always be a question (Ralph was "summoned" to Senator Peace's office for an hour in the middle of our committee meeting).

Well, this year seems to be shaping up as the "year of reports." Below is a list of all of the reports of interest:

As you may recall, CSDA Legislative Advocate Ralph Helm has been involved in a working group on AB 2838 (bill carrying recommendations from the CLG21st). The working group held its final meeting on May 4, 2000. Speaker Hertzberg's staff and CLG21 staff Ben Williams will craft the amendments that were developed as consensus

among the working group members. If the amendments reflect our input, it is likely that we will be able to fully support the bill. The bill is pending in the Assembly Appropriations Committee and when amended and passed, will be referred back to the Assembly Local Government Committee for a hearing.

The Little Hoover Commission report is out (see report #2). This report makes for interesting reading but the media, as usually cherry picked the more juicy parts and it remains to be seen if it will be used (especially in context) by legislators. Read this one if you can.

Another "current process" to be aware of is the Conference Committee on AB 1396 (local government finance). Committee members include: Senator Steve Peace (cochair), Assembly Member Dion Aroner (co-chair), Assembly Member John Longville, Assembly Member George Runner, Senator Don Perata, and Senator Charles Poochigian. The Committee has met twice (May 2, 2000 and May 8, 2000). The first hearing was an opportunity for local government representatives to answer the question "What is the problem?" as we discussed at our last Legislative Committee meeting. Yesterday's hearing was an opportunity for other stakeholders (CA Chamber of Commerce, CA Business Properties Association, CA Tax Reform, CA Taxpayers, CA Budget Project and Howard Jarvis Taxpayers) to answer the same question. Following yesterday's formal presentations, the Committee members and "stakeholders" switched seats - the legislators sat in the chair of the presenters and the presenters (including Ralph) were invited to sit in the legislators' podium chairs to see if each could get a different perspective on the problem and stimulate new discussion. CSDA President Rita Velasquez has formed what I call a "swat team" at Ralph's request for the purpose of providing him with instant support and input relative to his future interactions with this committee. The swat team is composed of CSDA Directors Chuck Beesley, Michael Glaze, William Miller, Harry Ehrlich, and Kit Carter.

Our next Committee meeting is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, June 8, 2000. We will be contacting you as soon as possible with final confirmation.

LEGISLATIVE ALERT

2000 Legislative Positions

The CSDA Legislation Committee reviews numerous bills each year that may be of interest to members. Board ratified *positions* are taken on most of them in March after which the Committee monitors progress until their conclusion. Given that most legislation undergoes numerous amendments during the legislative process, there could occur, from time-to-time, a change in a position. By accessing the California State Home Page, you can check on any bill and even subscribe to bills of interest where you are automatically notified by e-mail of activity.

The various "positions" include Support, Support with Amendments, Neutral, Oppose, Oppose unless Amended, Watch, or No Interest.

In addition to positions on each bill, one of three "priority" designations may be assigned.

Priority 1: Bills deemed to have the highest priority for CSDA for which the CSDA Legislative Advocate will actively lobby for or against the bill; present CSDA's position before all relevant legislative committees; and when warranted, employ CSDA's Grassroots Network.

Priority 2: CSDA will express its position and suggested amendments, where appropriate, in writing to the bill's author and relevant committees and present testimony.

Priority 3: CSDA will express its position in writing to the bill's author only and may provide testimony on a limited basis.

The format used in reporting this information is to list the bill, the last name of the author, the title and the position and priority taken on the bill by CSDA. AB means "Assembly Bill"; SB means "Senate Bill"; ACA means "Assembly Constitutional Amendment" and SCA means "Senate Constitutional Amendment".
