#### Scope of work:

- ~ Mechanically remove existing mortar bed down to existing structurally sound slab.
- Prepare surface by removing any foreign agents that could interfere with the bond of installation material
- ~ Apply Planibond (EBA) bonding agent to entire surface to receive topping.
- ~ Apply a 2 inch topping, utilizing Mapecem (202) from Mapei Products. 2 inches of thickness to be achieved with one application. (one lift)
- ~ If necessary to achieve a smooth finish surface a micro-topping film is to be applied to entire surface utilizing a feather finish material from Ardex Products.
- Cut control joints after material has set to minimize and prevent cracking.

All materials used for this project will be installed per manufacturer specifications and applications.

The product to be used for topping is a fast drying and low water ratio material and will allow traffic within 4 hours after its application.

We propose to furnish all skilled technicians, materials and equipment necessary to complete the scope of work described below.

#### Floor Leveling:

- Mechanically remove & haul-away loose mortar bed, down to original concrete slab or sound concrete.
- Pin floor for proper pre fill depth.
- Install Mapei Primer L advanced technology acrylic latex primer.
- Pre-fill floor using Mapei Novoplan II high strength, self-leveling cement-based underlayment and repair mix inclusive of 3/8" pea gravel.
- Prime floor again with Mapei Primer L
- Install Mapel Novoplan II high strength, self-leveling cement-based underlayment leveling a smooth flat surface ready for any type of floor covering.

#### QUALIFICATIONS:

Perform above work, furnish and install specified materials to the above areas as per manufacturers recommended application procedures. Elite Concrete Restoration is not responsible or liable for inherent qualities of concrete and concrete by-products, including but not limited to cracking, fracturing, delaminating, excessive substrate expansion, contraction, acts of nature, neglect or abuse exceeding standard industry tolerance. Portable Restrooms During Re-Flooring Project

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Due to the re-flooring project and for the safety of our patrons and staff, the main entrance door to the library has been closed. As a result, access to both public restrooms is inaccessible to the public. The temporary entrance to the library is located on the corner of Chapman and All American Way. Adult patrons have been directed to City Hall and the Police Department for restrooms. The distance between the temporary library entrance and the City Hall and Police Department restrooms can be difficult for some of our patrons who may have physical and or health limitations.

Library staff recommends providing portable restrooms to be placed on the parking lot by the temporary library entrance door. The rental for the units is for one month and includes weekly maintenance service.

Attachment A are the quotes and description of the two units from Southern California Sanitation.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize Library Staff to purchase the rental of portable restrooms from Southern California Sanitation not to exceed \$5,000.
